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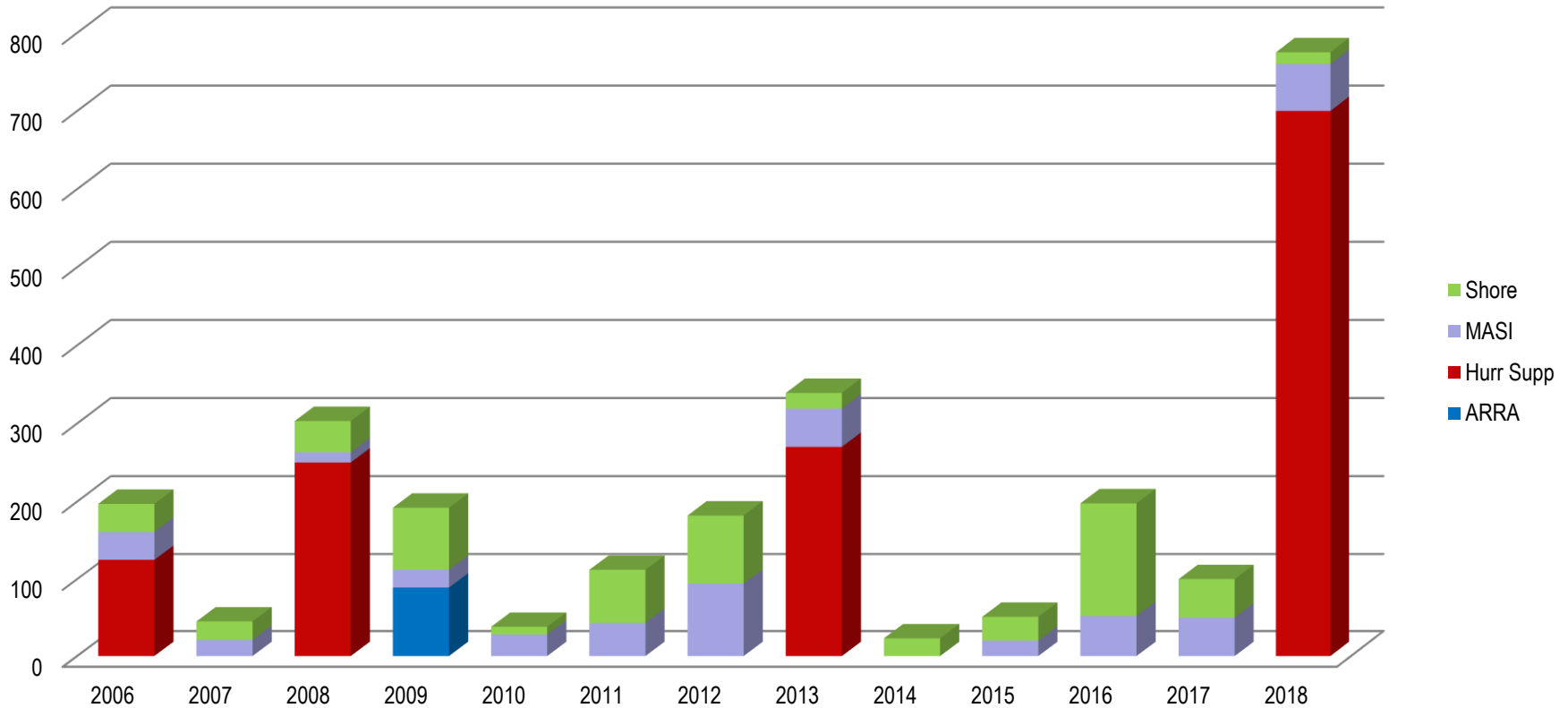




AC&I Historical Funding

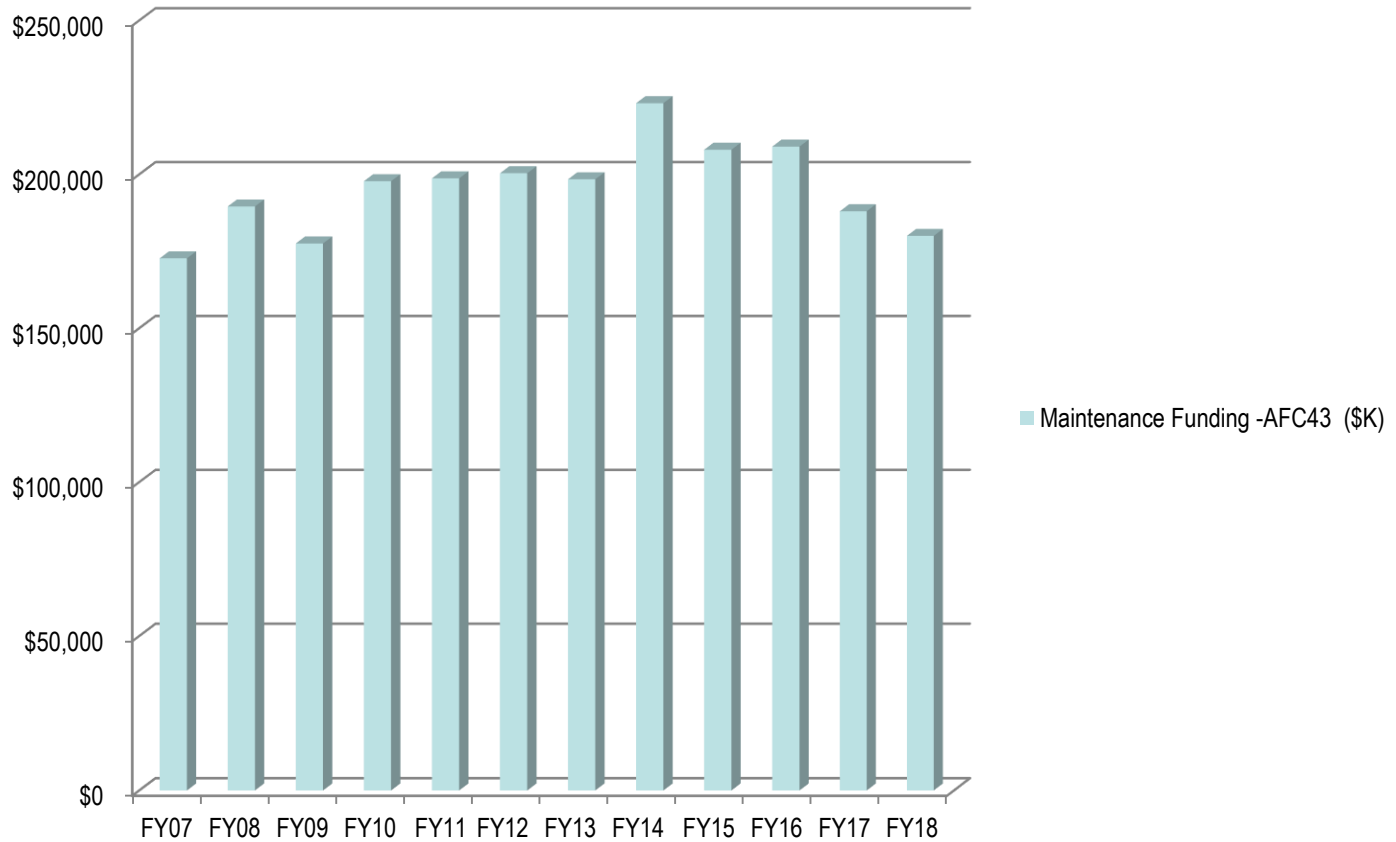




AFC-43 Historical Funding

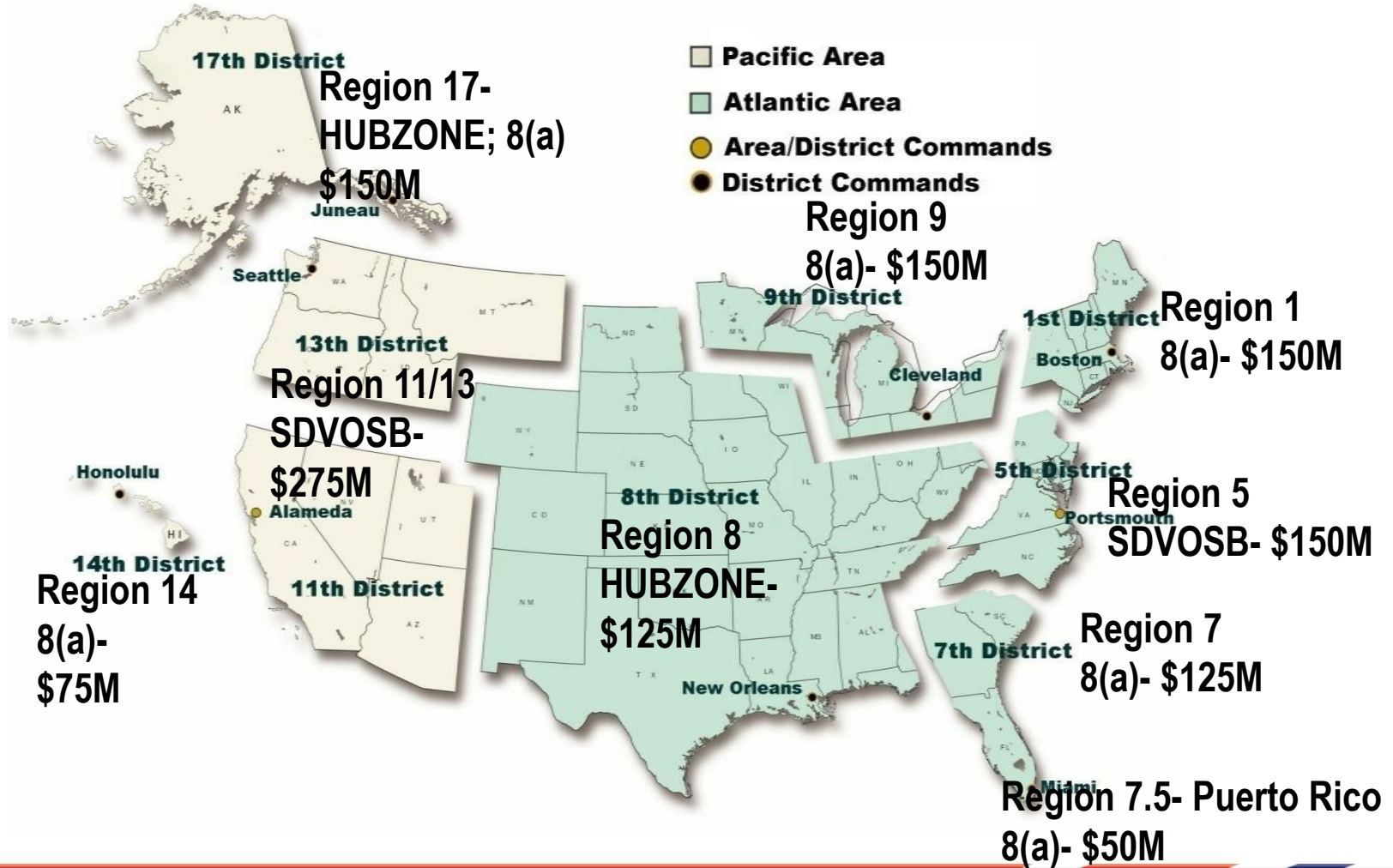


Maintenance Funding -AFC43 (\$K)
