2020 Senate Floor and Committee Votes

E2SHB 1521: Creates a barrier to additional contracting out of A/E/C services by state agencies. Passed House and Senate. AGC opposed.

E2SHB 2311: Modifies state anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets and state government greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets without pathways to achieve them. Passed House and Senate. AGC opposed.

ESHB 2322: Enacts supplemental transportation budget and resumes Connecting Washington projects paused due to passage of Initiative 976. Passed House and Senate. AGC supported.

ESSB 6248. Enacts supplemental capital budget, increasing capital investments by the state. Passed House and Senate. AGC supported.

ESSB 6492: Addresses many of the administrative concerns raised by the original surcharge enacted by H.B. 2158 but broadens the reach of the rate increase to all service-type businesses. Passed House and Senate. AGC opposed.

E2SHB 1100: Mandates a low carbon fuel standard, raising the price of gas thereby making it harder to increase funding for transportation. Passed House; passed Senate Environment, Energy and Technology Committee but did not reach Senate Floor. AGC opposed.
